We also stalled the product in various exhibition. We organized tree plantation program and study material distribution through our papad udyog.









HEALTH

After pandemic, we felt need of health facilities in our area is increasing day by day. So first we organised camps for our schools and women empowerment project. And increased its area by covering our Murbad and Ambernath Tehsil with the help of our partners like Srujana Group and Mahaganapati Hospital.
